MOOROODUC STATION

Melways 105 K9

From the north: Turn right off Peninsula Link freeway (Exit No 15) at Frankston-Flinders Road. Left at Sages Road. Left at Moorooduc Highway. Right at Two Bays Road then first left into main entrance.

From the south: Turn left off Peninsula Link freeway (Exit No 17) at Bungower Road. Right at Moorooduc Highway. Left at Two Bays Road then first left into main entrance.

MORNINGTON STATION

Melways 145 G1

From the north: Turn right off Peninsula Link freeway (Exit No 18) at Mornington-Tyabb Road. Right at Yuilles Road. Mornington Station car park is on the right just over the railway crossing.

From the south: Turn left off Peninsula Link freeway (Exit No 19) and take Nepean Highway towards Mornington. Turn right at Mornington-Tyabb Road. Left at Yuilles Road. Mornington Station car park is on the right just over the railway crossing.

TANTI STATION

Melways 105 A12

On Bungower Road (unmanned station) - no ticketing or facilities are available at this station.
